Excerpt from **The Moving Picture Boy** entry on Silva:

“...Horácio Silva had the luck to play the lead in one of the most charming and atmospheric of all children’s films: **"ANIKI-BÓBÓ"**, which Manoel de Oliveira directed in the precipitous old waterfront city of Opporto, while the Second World War rumbled to the north and east of the peninsula.

It’s a story of chivalry and rivalry among the local kids, with the gentle, high-minded Carlitos (Silva) so romantically obsessed with Terezinha (Fernanda Matos) - to the fury of the thuggish Eduardo (António Santos, a splendid Mussolini-in-short-pants) - that he steals a doll

from the "Shop of Temptations" to present her with.

What distinguishes **"ANIKI-BÓBÓ"**, aside from the humour and excitement of its plot, is the grubby beauty of the setting, and the strain of dreamy poetry that surrounds the characters. It would have been worthy of Pagnol, and the kids are terrific.”
