Films & Filming - September 1963 - review of "MIKRES AFRODITES":

"Nicos Koundouros, a wild young director from Athens, brought with him "MIKRES AFRODITES" ("Little Aphrodites"), a nymphettes and shepherds tale of copulation in ancient Greece, introducing in Kleopatra Rota a wistful Hellenic Lolita. The photography was conscientiously arty but nevertheless at times stunningly beautiful.

A plaintive score for pipes was completely at variance with the film's primitive eroticism and brutality and served to emphasise the director's failure to create a film idyll, which - according to the press book - he had been striving to do.

Often quite embarrassing was Koundouros' predilection for legs of all shapes and sizes, bare, clad, wet, dry, pale or bronzed, shot from all possible angles..."
